REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This matter is before the Court on the Receiver's First Motion to Allow Claims (Dkt. 517). On April 14, 2004, a hearing was held and the Receiver and Examiner outlined the method by which claims were submitted as approved unsecured claims against the Receivership estate. At the hearing, an amended listing of such claims, Amended Exhibit A to the Receiver's Motion, was presented, and that listing was subsequently filed with the Court on April 27, 2004 (Dkt. 540). The methodology complied with the Court's earlier Order regarding how claims should be established (Dkt. 223). No objections to the proposed allowed claims have been filed. Thus, the undersigned recommends that the claims set forth in the Amended Exhibit A (Dkt. 540) to the Receiver's Motion (Dkt. 517), totaling \$16,194,437.40, should be allowed as unsecured claims against the Receivership estate.
